Each comprehensive school leaver must apply for further studies through the joint application procedure in the spring or through the rolling application procedure.





Preparatory education for programmes leading to an upper secondary qualification (max. 1 year).



The first certificate
or qualification is free of charge.
Both are free of charge for those who take a dual certificate or qualification.
Learners are entitled to education free of charge until the end of the year when they reach the age of 20.

Compulsory education lasts until the age of 18.

Compulsory education ends sooner for students who obtain a matriculation examination certificate or a vocational qualification before the age of 18.
