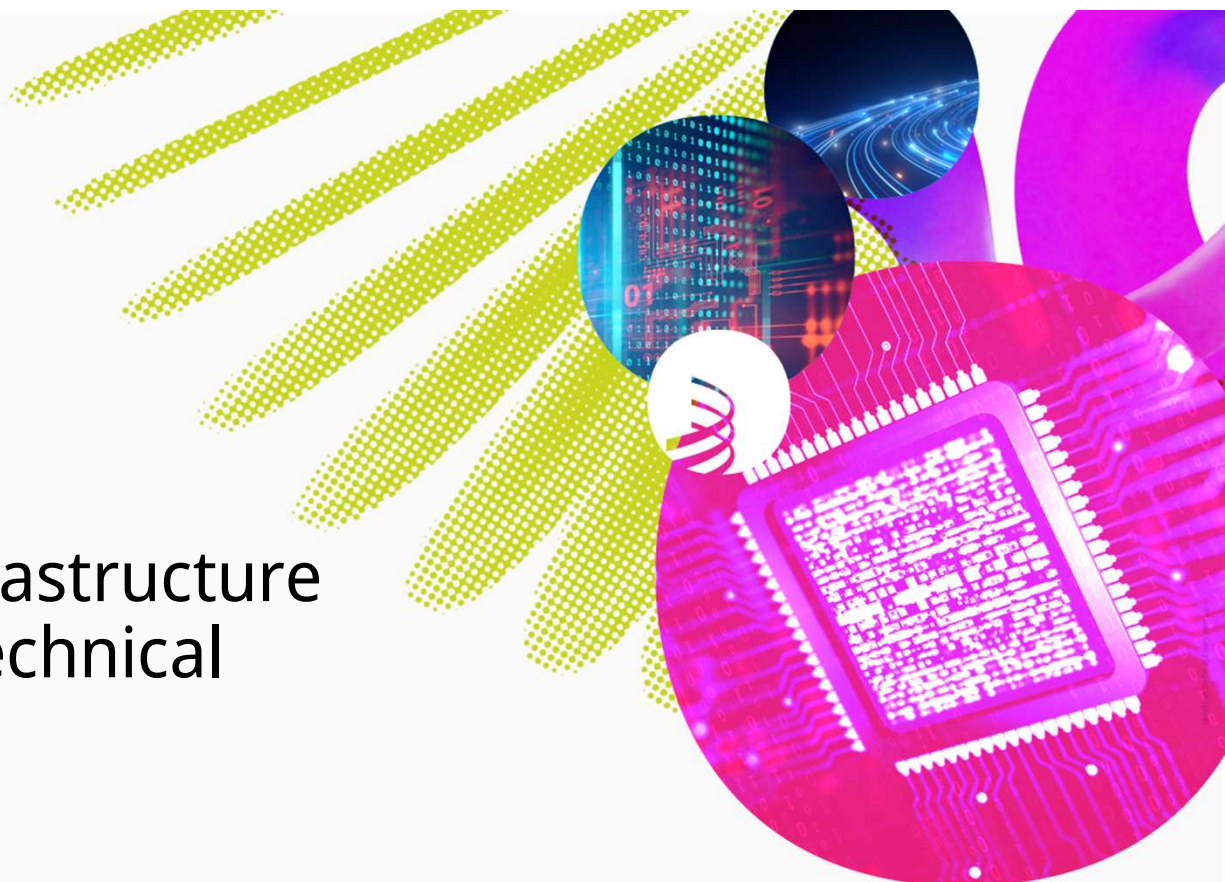

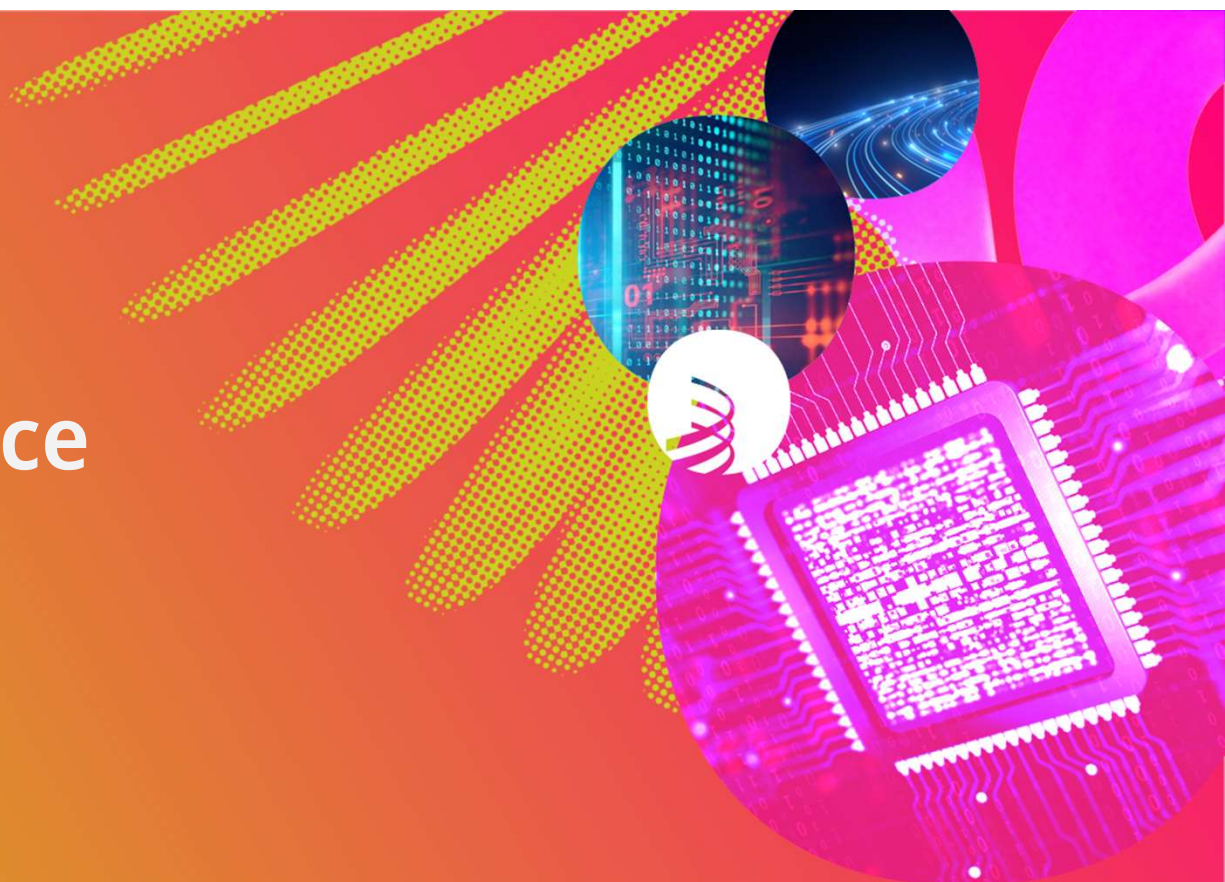

About the Artificial Intelligence Infrastructure Interchange (AIII)

- Pronounced as “A-triple-I”
- It is a WIPO initiative that facilitates global dialogue on the technical and operational aspects of the intellectual property system in the context of artificial intelligence.
- **AIII is not just about copyright**
 - Copyright infrastructure is well known, but AI raises questions across all IP
 - AI is increasingly used as a tool in the innovation process. As AI evolves, infrastructure questions will also evolve



AIII – Key Principles



Neutral Forum

- For creators, rightsholders, innovators, AI developers, and other non-government experts to exchange ideas and explore practical solutions



Focus on practical, operational aspects

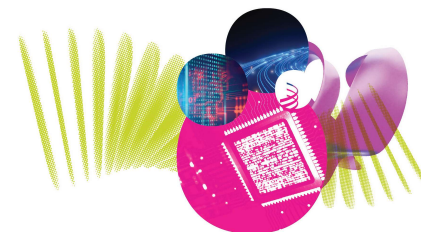
- To effectively support creators, rightsholders and innovators, promoting the development of AI technology in a rapidly evolving environment

TEN – Values Commitments

Openness and inclusivity

Participation shall be open to all eligible technical experts;

Voluntary engagement

Members shall contribute on a voluntary basis, according to their interests and resources;

Transparency

Activities, processes and decisions shall be communicated openly and clearly within the Network, with due regard to potential business sensitivities;

Respect for confidentiality

Members-only meetings of the Network will be held under the Chatham House Rule to facilitate productive dialogue. In addition, members must maintain the confidentiality of any information shared within the Network that is designated or marked as confidential;

Knowledge sharing and mutual learning

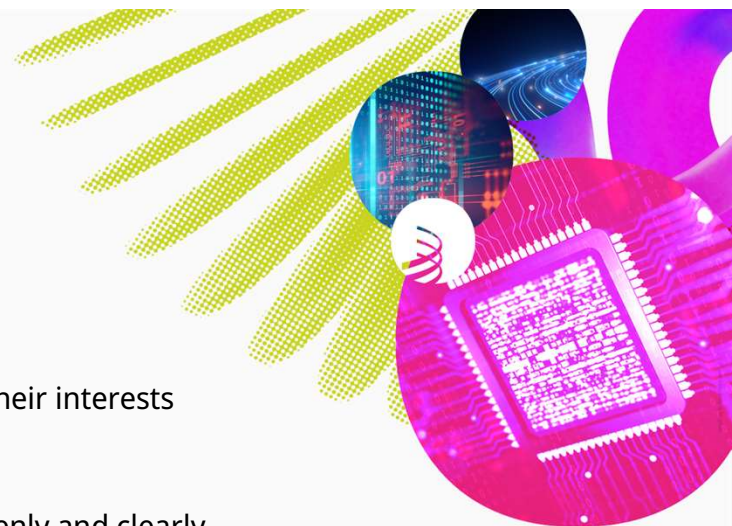
Members shall share experiences, lessons and resources to foster collective progress;

Good-faith focus on technical and operational issues

Members shall commit to good faith discussions of technical issues and shall refrain from engaging in policy advocacy or commercial or other promotion of a particular standard, tool, system or product in which the member has a direct financial interest;

Respect for diversity

Cultural, regional and institutional diversity shall be acknowledged and valued.



TEN – Objectives



The TEN shall have the following strategic objectives

- Prioritize identification of potential technical solutions to challenges and opportunities arising for the intellectual property system from the development and deployment of generative AI;
- Share and disseminate state-of-the-art approaches, methodologies and practices, including via the compilation of a repository of papers and other reports on technical elements of AI and IP infrastructure;
- Facilitate mutual learning and peer support among technical experts;
- Develop a common lexicon of relevant terminology to provide consistency across discussions;
- Foster cross-sectoral, inter-industry, and international cooperation on key technical challenges and opportunities at the intersection of AI and intellectual property.



Emerging Topics in the TEN Discussions

- Importance of a common lexicon
- Considerations of metadata in the age of AI
- Consideration of types of “AI-generated content”
- Industry-specific and cross-industry intersections with AI
- Implications of AI for “personal characteristics”

- Overview of questions and opportunities



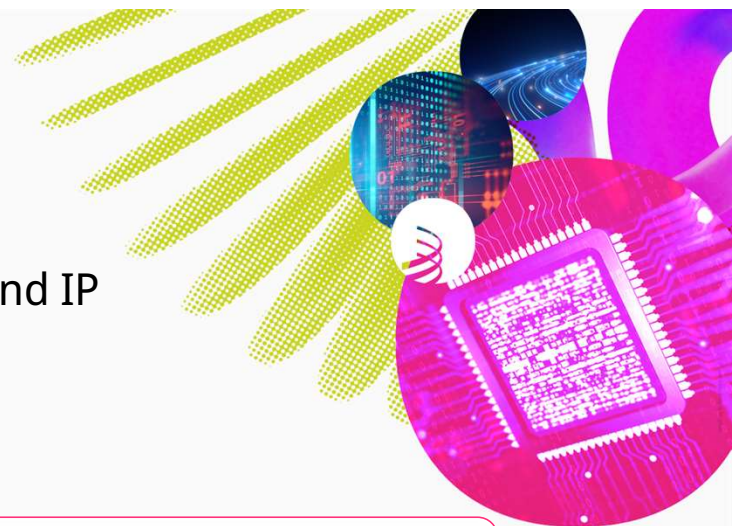
Overview of Infrastructure

- Stock-taking of existing infrastructure and infrastructure that is being built across the creative industries



Specific Issues at the Intersection of AI and IP

- Identifying in a structured, detailed and granular way, i.e., “challenges and opportunities”



While solutions discussed within the TEN may inform or inspire subsequent work undertaken by individuals or organizations outside of the Network, the TEN itself is not tasked with designing, developing or engineering technical solutions.

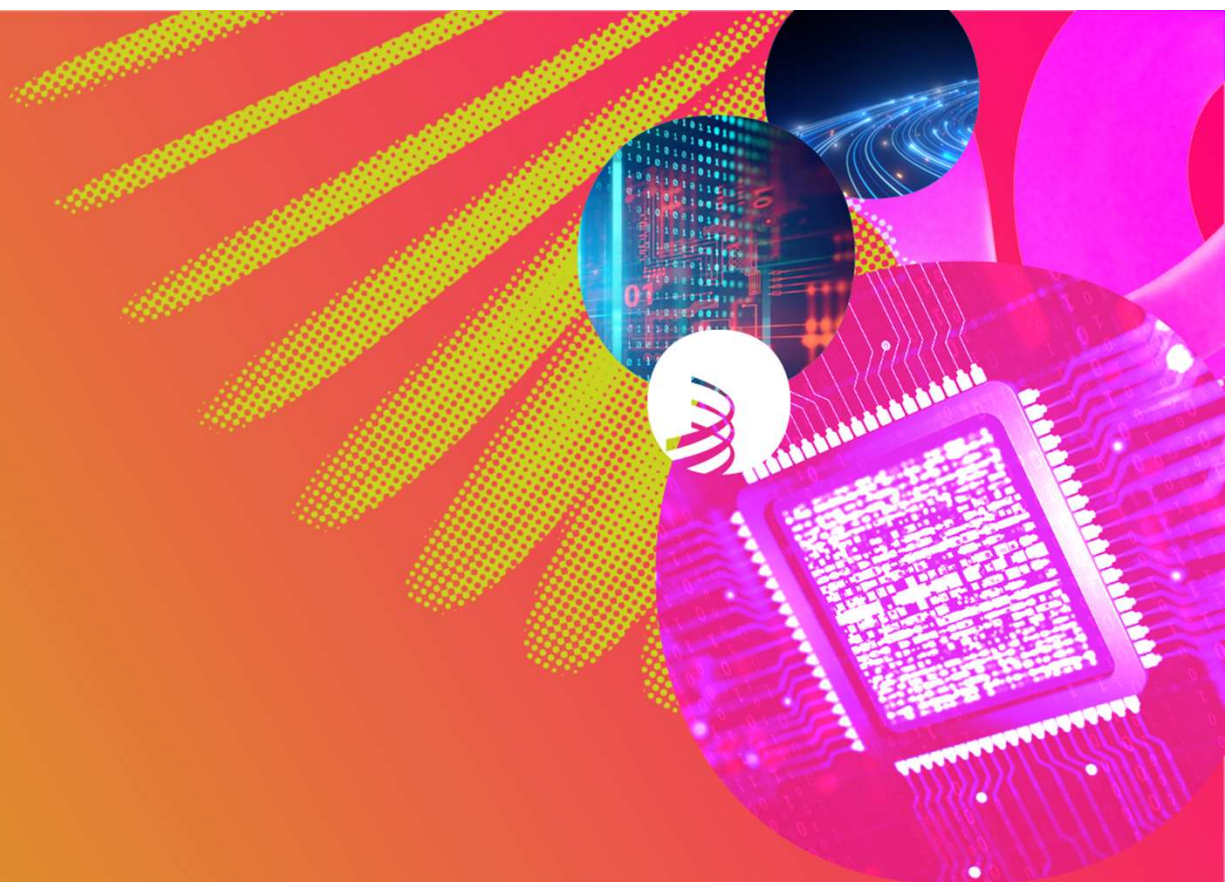
